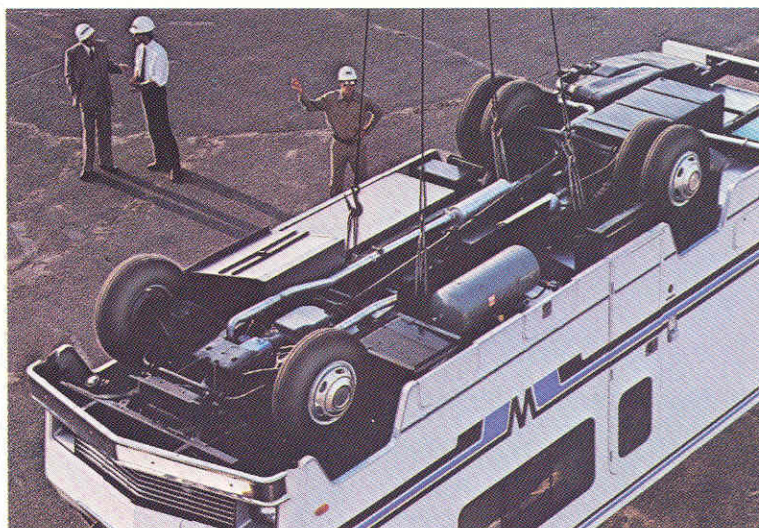
This automated welding system delivers remarkable accuracy. Time after time.

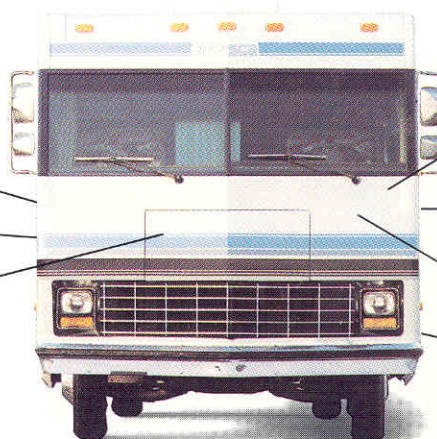

The toughest test we have to pass is our own.

Testing, like every other aspect of Itasca construction, is state-of-the-art.

A special heat chamber subjects molded plastic parts to temperature extremes from -100 to +400 degrees.

A unique system sprays gravel at our paint finishes with 70 lbs. of air pressure to check chip resistance.

Another device is used every week to randomly test the lamination strength of our own Thermo-Panel sidewalls.

We routinely run vibration tests. Salt water spray tests. Weight distribution tests.



From the engineers who design Sunflyers — to the craftsmen who build them — to the quality control specialists who inspect them — there's a common commitment to product excellence.

We even test the brand name refrigerators, ovens and radios that are installed in Itasca — to insure our standards are maintained.

Then, of course, there's our famous drop test. A free fall onto pavement. Upside down. To make certain nothing buckles. Or becomes unbolted or unsafe.

And to make sure our testing stands the test, every Itasca built is manufactured under the watchful eyes of 30 quality control specialists. Along with voluntary Quality Circles who are always looking for ways to build Itasca even better.



The optional electric step automatically extends when you open the door — retracts when you close it. And even if it's locked in place — it retracts when you turn on the ignition.

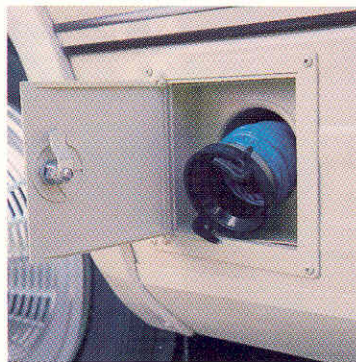
We put more into Itasca—so you get more out of it.

Itasca meets or exceeds all State and Federal motor home safety codes written. But we don't stop there.

The wheel wells are roto-cast automotive plastic. So they won't break down under the pounding of rocks and road salt.

The sub-flooring is aluminum. So it won't rust.

The roof is one piece — carefully joined to the side-walls for a tight seal — to prevent leakage.



The sewer hose tucks away, out of sight, when it's not in use — but offers convenient, neat access when you need it.

The fuel lines have rubber sleeves wherever they pass through the frame. So they won't rub.

The appliances have steel tie-downs. There's an 18-gauge steel frame contained within the sidewalls. And the driver's

compartment is shielded by a steel firewall.

We've even designed extra payload into Itasca. So there's plenty of room for all the gear you need. Even some you don't need.



Exterior storage compartments are easy to pack and unpack. And Sunflyer's GVWR leaves lots of safe payload capacity.

And we've organized the storage areas and holding tanks for weight distribution. So that empty or full — your Itasca stays evenly balanced. From front to back. And from side to side.



The huge wardrobe has special drawers for small things. And an automatic light that helps you find them.

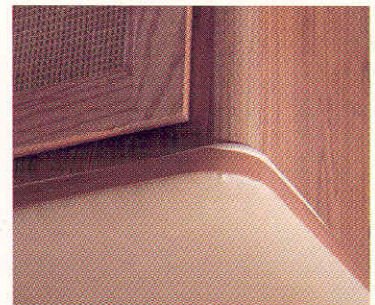


The spare tire cover not only looks great — it screw locks for easy access.
