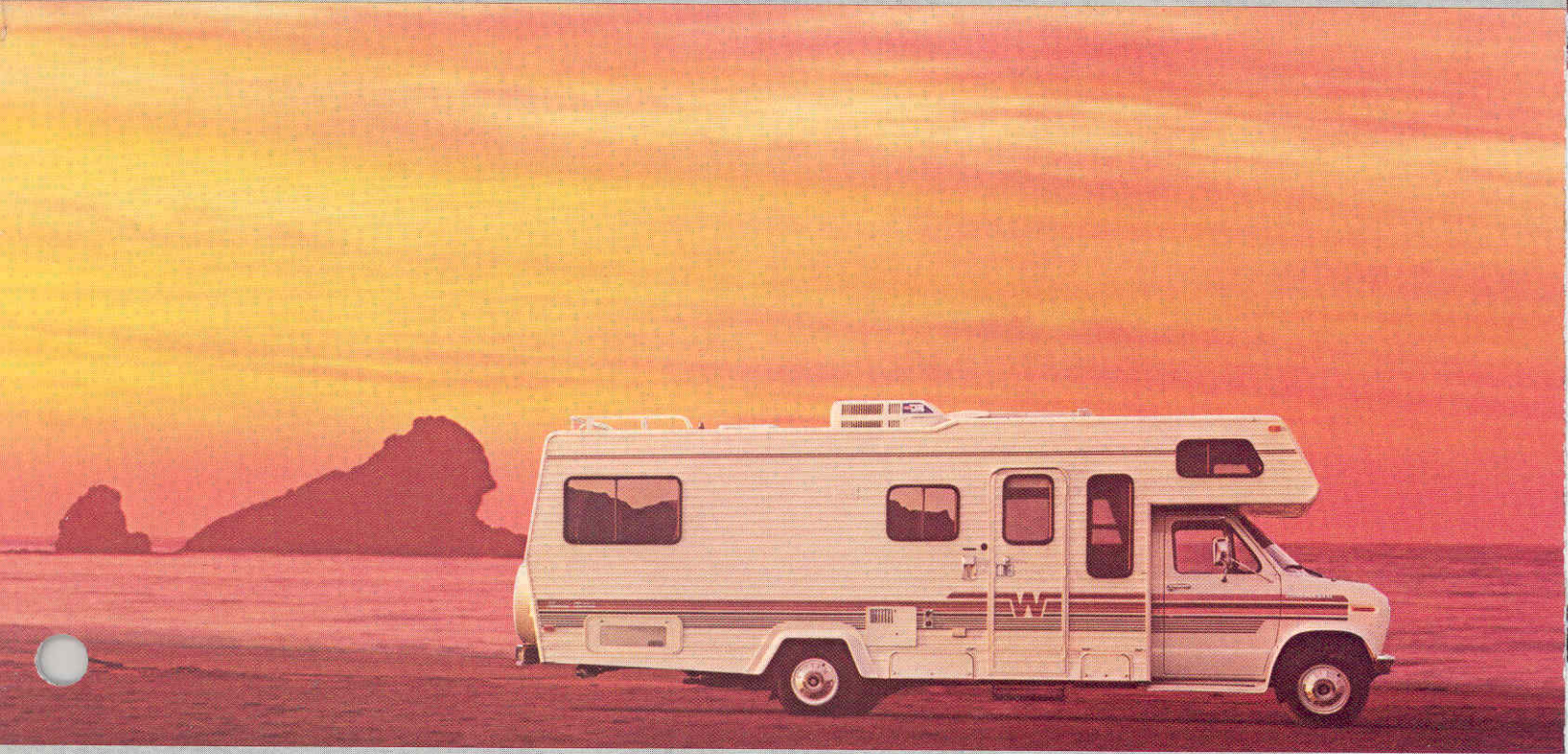

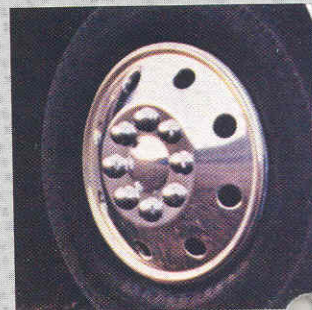

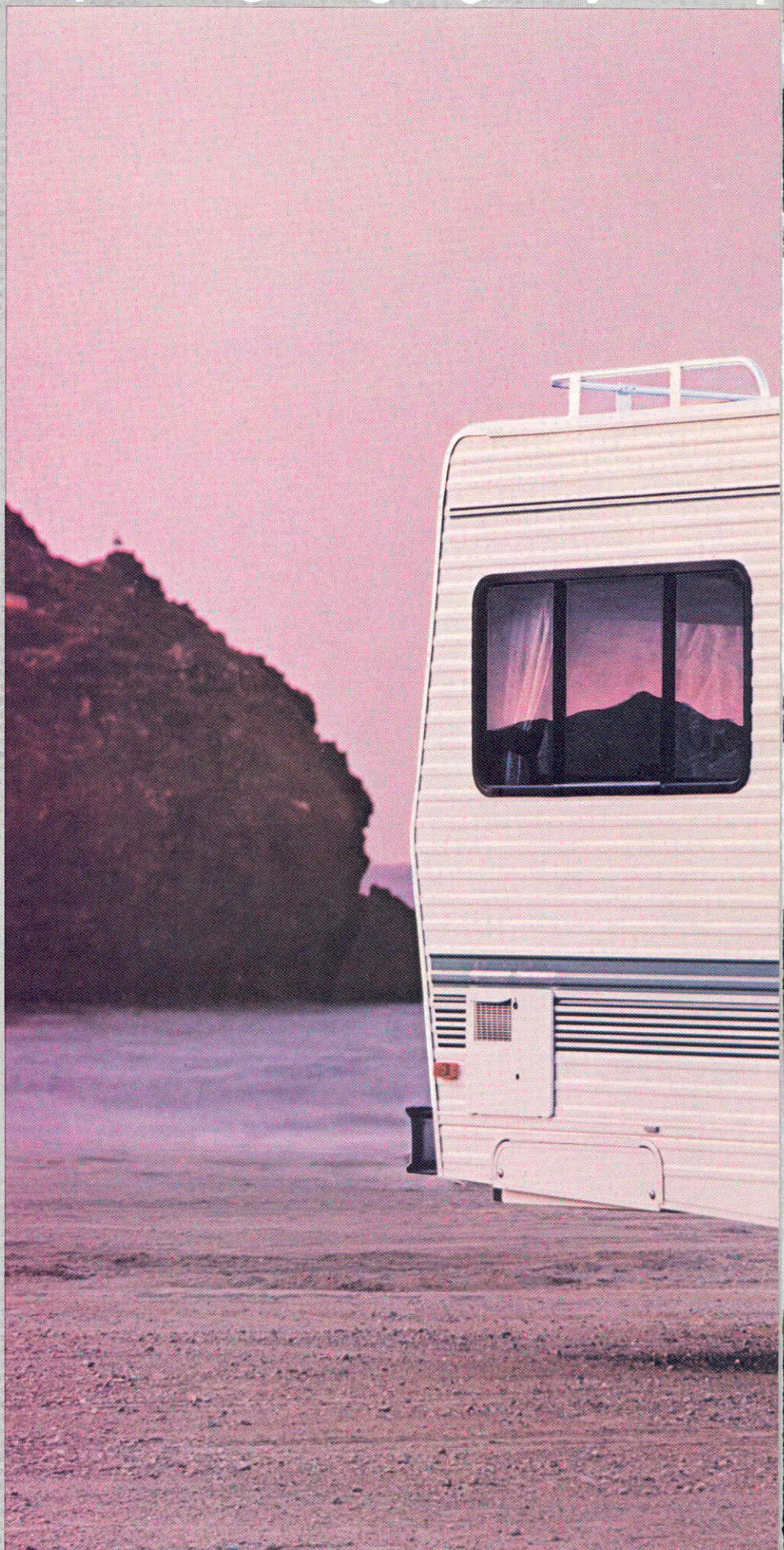
It's no wonder, then, that people keep coming back to Minnie Winnie. It is, in many circles, not merely a mini motor home, it is *the* mini motor home.

It forms the basis for a very drivable motor home which has proven itself an everlasting favorite of Winnebago owners. A mere 20 feet in length, this spunky motor home has such an exceptionally roomy interior that it actually sleeps five.

In the Minnie Winnie 21RB, we took our talent for efficient use of space and brought it to life in a pleasant, inviting floorplan. A convertible dinette/bed and front overhead bunk sleep three, or you can choose an optional sprung couch and sleep four.

The larger Minnie Winnies, 24 and 26 feet, bring all of the livability and luxury of Class A motor homes to the Class C category.

There are three choices in the popular 24 foot length, a 24RC, 24RB and 24RS. With its front sprung couch and optional swivel chairs and ice maker, the 24RB is the ideal coach for casual entertaining. The 24RC offers the privacy of a rear bedroom with either a double bed or bunks. The 24RS is a brand new floorplan this year with a rear lounge and table. All the 24-footers sleep four or five, depending on the options selected.

The largest Minnie Winnie, the 26RU, offers an extra roomy bedroom with a double bed. With its front overhead bunk and dinette—both standard features on all the Minnie Winnies—this 26-footer sleeps five.

Finally, Minnie Winnie offers your choice of a Ford or Chevrolet chassis. You can take either one on all but the 20 and 26 foot models. The 20RG comes exclusively with a Chevy cab, the 26RU with a Ford.

With so much to offer, it's not surprising that Minnie Winnie is such a popular choice.

The most difficult part of designing and building a mini motor home is not filling it up with all the necessary features.

It's doing so while still leaving room for the most important feature. You.

Minnie Winnie does both with ease.

Each living area is designed for relaxing on the road. The dinette is perfect for quick snacks or full meals. The lounge area provides a comfortable setting for conversation or games. And beds are spacious and soft—just right for a restful night or an afternoon nap.

Throughout the coach, there is a light, airy feel from the large windows. Cool fluorescent lighting in the galley and decorative wall lamps supplement the natural light. At night, directional reading lamps let you stay up with a good book while everyone else sleeps.

Such functional details are common in Minnie Winnie. All edges and corners on tables and overhead cabinet bottoms have been carefully rounded. Furnishings are full size, counters are normal height, and beds are spacious and soft. Overhead, the cabinets have oak stile and rail doors which swing up and stay in place for easy access. Under the carpeting, there's a separate pad for extra comfort.

In all, Winnebago's expertise in designing mini motor homes surpasses any other company.

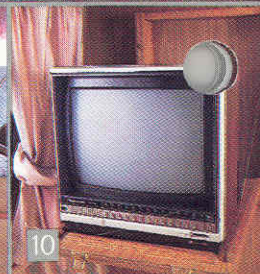
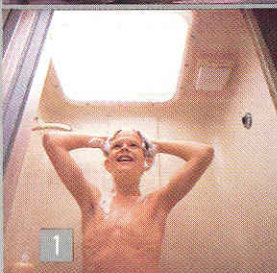

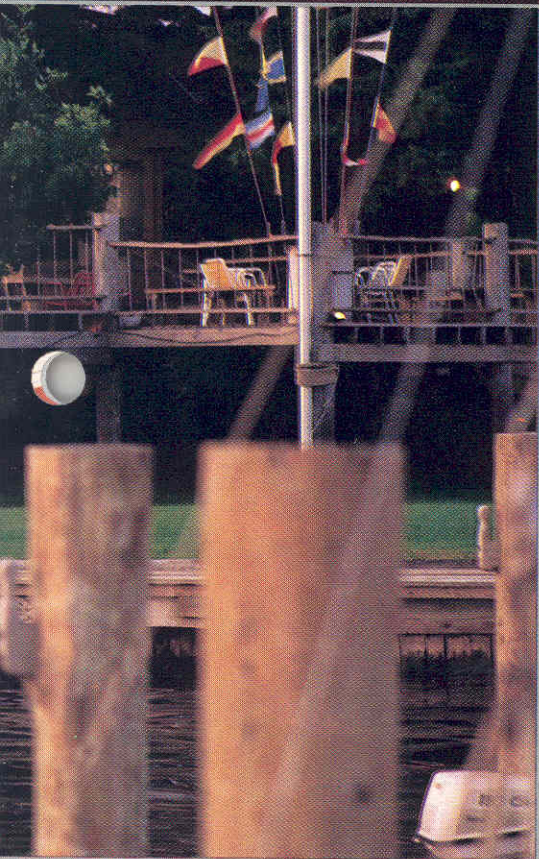

Even though Minnie Winnie is designed to be more economical and more comfortable to drive, it is every bit as livable as any Class A coach.

The galley is functionally arranged, with a four burner range, glass door oven and a range hood with exhaust vent. There's a large single door refrigerator, or you can opt for an even larger double door refrigerator with electronic controls. With either, you'll get the safety and convenience of three-way power.

The bathroom has brushed brass-tone fixtures, a mirrored medicine cabinet and a stand-up shower with a flexible shower head. In the larger models, the shower shroud is molded from a single piece of sturdy plastic with extra head and shoulder room. A shower skylight is also available in some models.

To maintain just the right interior temperature, Minnie Winnie provides a 24,000 or 34,000 BTU furnace. Whichever you select, you'll have the convenience of electronic ignition. Automotive and roof air conditioners and generator are also available.

Up front, Minnie Winnie puts you behind the wheel of one of the most drivable motor homes on the road. The cab pampers you with low-back bucket seats, tilt steering, power steering and sunvisors. You can also select six-way power seats, cruise control

and a deluxe AM/FM/ cassette stereo system to help melt away the miles.

That kind of attention to detail doesn't end in Minnie Winnie's cab. Throughout the interior, you'll find all kinds of added touches and fine craftsmanship.

There's a mirror on either the bathroom door or inside the wardrobe door. Vents in both the bathroom and the coach help circulate air. And such simple touches as wall light switches, a magazine rack and a spice rack combine to create a home-like feel that is rare in most minis.

Other features which add to your comfort include single and double ceiling lights, blinds with curtain panels and an optional decorator kit with a handsome weather center and wall clock.

Minnie Winnie has plenty of qualities which will be especially appreciated by the experienced motor homer. A space saving, fold-down stand is available for your television set. Floor courtesy lights and a deluxe monitor panel are part of an optional interior conveniences package.

Every part of Minnie Winnie comes together in an exceptionally attractive setting. It is the kind of look few motor homes seem to achieve at any price. Yet Minnie Winnie does so at a very attractive one.

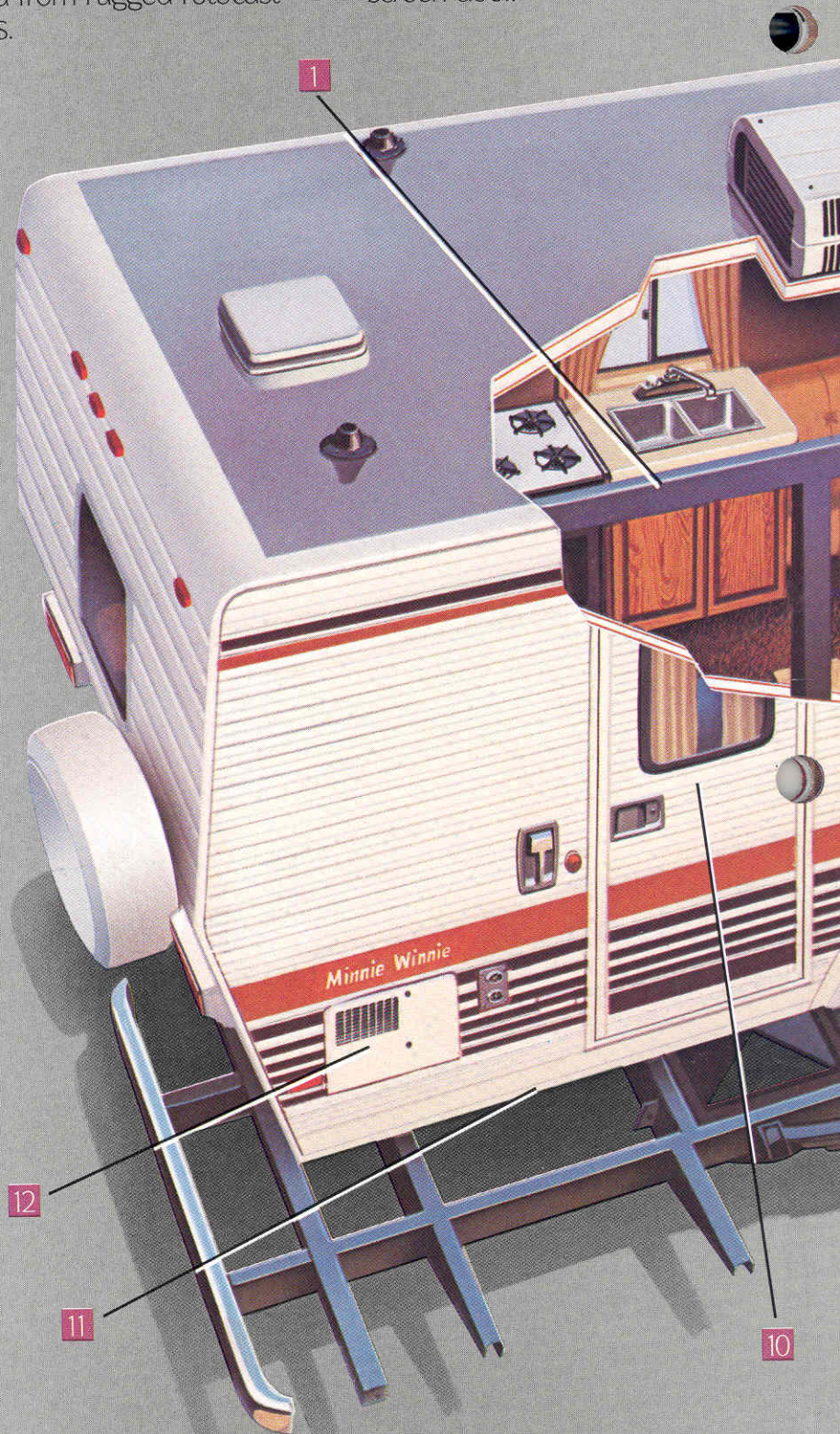
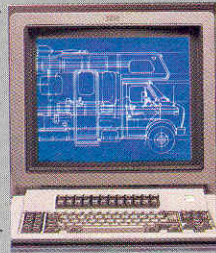

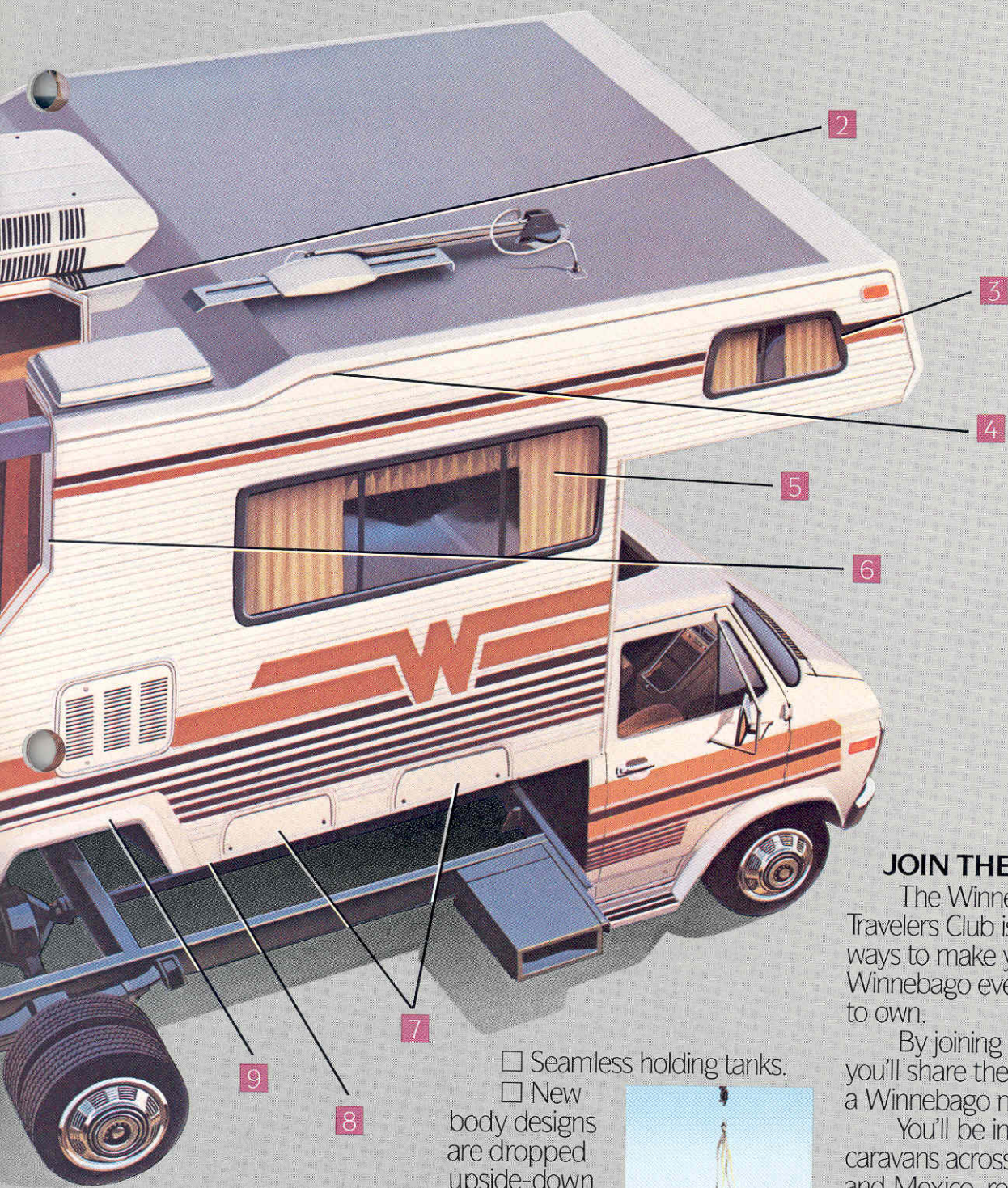
